Pass2Class Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is Pass2Class?

A. Pass2Class is a program that encourages students in grades 1-12 to use public transit instead of a car to get to and from school. The 2022 program offers free County Connection, Tri Delta Transit, WestCAT, or AC Transit bus passes for up to two (2) students per household for up to two months.

Q. Who is eligible:

A. If your child attends a K-12 school in Contra Costa County, is in grades 1-12 and is 19 years of age or younger, you are eligible to apply to the Pass2Class program.

A parent or guardian must complete the application and pledge that their student will ride the bus to and from school instead of being driven. The parent or guardian must also agree to complete a follow-up Pass2Class survey.

Q. What are the program rules?

A. Free bus passes are available for up to **two (2) students** per household, while supplies last. Each eligible student will receive one of the following:

- **West County Schools:** Two WestCAT 31-day fixed route bus passes OR Two AC Transit 31-day youth passes, depending on the school.
- **Central County Schools:** County Connection bus pass valid for unlimited school trips through September 30, 2022.
- **East County Schools:** Two Tri Delta Transit 20-Ride Passes.
- **Southwest County Schools:** County Connection bus pass valid for unlimited school trips through September 30, 2022.
